 - YES Show all Related Tasks = It will show all the tasks related to the current object record regardless of who owns it. All the filters in the picklist respect this property and will show related tasks accordingly. To see all of your tasks you would need to select My Tasks from the picklist on the component
- Show Null First: Shows tasks with no due date first in the list
- Additional Field 1: Select any additional field 1 to display in the list
- Additional Field 2: Select any additional field 2 to display in the list
- Hyperlink Open Behavior:
 - o It has the option to select one of the four values. i.e.
 - All in a Modal Popup window = It will open all records in modal popup window
 - All Navigate to Record page = It will take you to the record detailed page for all records.
 - **Task in a Modal Popup window** = It will open only the task record in the modal popup window.
 - **Task Navigate to Record page** =It will take you to the record detailed page for task record only.
